He began his career with the General Electric Company in 1960, and in 1981 became the Company’s 8th Chairman & CEO. During his 20+ year tenure as CEO, the Company's market capitalization rose from \$13 billion to \$400 billion. In 2000, he was named “Manager of the Century” by Fortune magazine.
