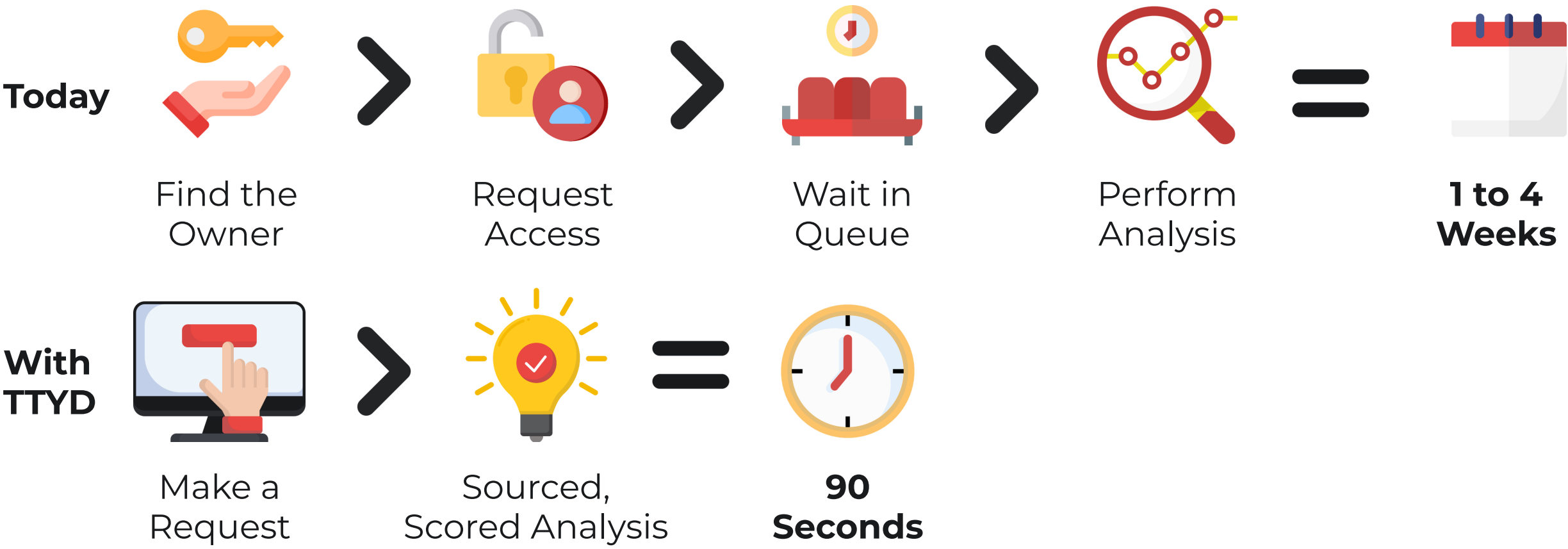


The Problem



Data fragmentation across countries and functions makes **coordination the real constraint**. No **governance framework** exists to say what must be resolved before software touches production data: access, authorization, accountability. Time-to-insight runs 1–4 weeks, so **decisions get made without evidence**. **At a two-week cycle time, only questions worth two weeks of effort get asked**.

Objective and Scope

One centralized entry point reaching all business domains. Focus on supply, commercial, and finance. One sourced answer inside a single sitting, minutes instead of weeks.

Every answer ships with its evidence. Queries run, tables touched, per-call errors, automated quality verdict (LLM as a Judge).

Governance made structural. Data reach declared in reviewable configuration; every routing decision auditable after the fact.

Not a BI replacement, a free-form SQL interface, or an autonomous actor. The system reads and reports; it never writes to the source.
